



My Choice Not A Crisis!
Anti-Abortion Center (AAC) Regulation Policy Agenda

- **No public funding for AACs**
 - Eliminate the Alternatives to Abortion (A2A) program
 - Prohibit diversion of TANF and other social safety net systems to the A2A program
- **Regulate AACs**
 - Require any organization that receives A2A funding to give clients accurate information about their pregnancy;
 - Require any organization that receives A2A funding to provide or make referrals to providers of comprehensive reproductive health services;
 - Require any organization that receives A2A funding to publish an annual public report on the use of public grants and contract funds.
 - Require any organization that receives A2A funding to be subject to public audits
 - Prohibit any organization that receives A2A funding from providing referrals for, or promoting “Abortion pill reversal”
 - Establish a AAC hotline, similar to fraud lines, for reporting:
 - Harassment of patients;
 - Dissemination of private information;
 - Personal experiences at AACs;
 - Disinformation found on AAC websites;
 - Deceptive advertising about services offered;
 - AACs that provide “abstinence” education in public schools.
 - Require any organization that receives A2A funding to implement HIPPA style protections for the data they receive and require them to provide their clients notice of these data protection requirements, and prohibit gathering of any data not needed to provide services (such as # of sexual partners)
 - Require any organization that receives A2A funding to inform clients of their privacy policy, whether and how they aggregate personal information, and how they use personal information.
 - Require AACs to only staff medical professionals
 - Require AACs to use medical terminology only
 - Prohibit public schools from engaging with AACs or other organizations that fail to provide comprehensive, age appropriate, evidence based info to teach sexuality education classes or curricula, or to refer students to these organizations
 - Require public schools that do refer to AACs to make it clear that AACs do not provide abortion care



- **Prohibit Abortion Pill Reversal in Texas**
- **Repeal state mandated lies (The Right to Know Pamphlet & the requirement of sharing it)**
- **Fund repro-health, prenatal care, and postpartum care**
 - **Fully fund TANF, SNAP & social safety net programs**
 - **Create a Reproductive Care Fund**
 - Requires that TANF and other social safety net budgets be maintained or increased by X% before funding can be allocated to this fund. The money would come from A2A funding
 - Fund recipients must either provide comprehensive repro healthcare or provide referrals for comprehensive repro healthcare services in order to be eligible for funding
 - This fund will cover
 - Travel costs to access
 - Pregnancy tests
 - Contraception
 - Emergency contraception
 - Abortion
 - Diapers
 - Baby formula
 - Doulas
